Items of business – WHS & Facilities Management

1) Deterioration of goals

a) ST contacted mobile welder guy – hopefully here Tuesday 13 April. Will also look at gates and other metal items that are broken or damaged – ST MET ON THURSDAY 15 April

UPDATE – ST Met 15 April with welder on-site prior to committee meeting. He is going to undertake various repairs as required on a 'do and charge' basis given the nature of the repairs.

2) Foot baths and general appearance

a) ST to follow up Macca – again

General consensus that a weekly / monthly works schedule be formed with an emphasis on hygiene and cleanliness.

3) Driveway / point of entry

a) Suggest leave as is, accept the risk for the moment as the site will be closed off prior to season start; place burden across to builders and / or get the to fill with spoil

Resolution: That PMHHA accept the risk at present, pending commencement of building works. Should building work not commence by season start, PMHHA to revisit the risk

ACTION: Vote - Yes / No

Resolution set aside on the basis that construction works have commenced. ST will advise the PMC to undertake talks with the PM and contractors to use spoil to remedy the entry / exit road in the interim.

4) Grass length and grass clippings (communications from users)

- a) Noted not much we can do in the current weather. 1 x cut per month. Provide instruction to contractors to cut "away" from the playing surface and / or catch their clippings.
- b) Suggest a second cut per month for April / May to get the length down to a manageable level

Resolution: That PMHHA approve 2 extra lawn mowing runs over the months of April / May and provide instruction to the contractors to catch the grass and / or cut away from the fields after the week of 03

May 2021

ACTION: Vote – Yes 5 for 0 against resolution passed.

It was also noted that the current contractors are engaged directly by PMHC with PMHHA paying the difference. The above works would be from PMHHA's own funds. 5 for 0 against

ST provided an update – 40's / 45's Mens selected and ready to leave. Expressed the need / desires for a 50s team in Grafton as it will assist PMHHA with future bidding for tournaments. Currently have approx.

8 people Eol'd for 50s Men
